It is disappointing that FYK Ltd are persisting with their application for this site to be used by Wren Kitchens when their application has already been refused twice.

I have made objections on both of these occasions and am doing so again given the fact that any previous objections made are not being taken into consideration for this application.

This proposed facility would not only add noise pollution to an already noise polluted village due to the airport, but will also have a damaging effect on the natural environment. In addition, the B1256 is already a busy and dangerous stretch of road and the addition of such a facility will make the situation far worse with huge lorries using the road practically 24/7.

The site is simply not suitable for such a facility, it will cause untold damage to the village environment and all of its residents health and wellbeing, increase noise pollution, cause untold increase in traffic on the already busy B1256 and will destroy lots of natural habitat for wildlife. There must be more suitable sites for such a facility in an already fully industrialised area well away from our small village.
