



Plate or framed Doors - externally hinged

Doors hinged top/bottom pin style - prevention of tool attack on pins




Plate or framed Doors - suggestion for internal hinges


Steel cantilever arms in steel pin pivot blocks welded or bolted with locknut fastenings to surround frame and door frame
