Limits on Indebtedness Determination 2013

The Secretary of State as respects all local housing authorities in England, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 171 and 173 of the Localism Act 2011, after consulting such representatives of local government and relevant professional bodies as appear to be appropriate, makes the following determination:

Citation and commencement

This determination may be cited as the Limits on Indebtedness Determination 2013. It has effect from 1 April 2012.

Amendment to the Limits on Indebtedness Determination 2012

1. The Limits on Indebtedness Determination 2012 is amended as set out in paragraph 2 below.
2. In the table in Annex B , for the authorities listed in column 1 of the table below, substitute -
 - 2.1 the amounts set out in column 2 of the table below for the amounts set out in the column headed "Forecast end-year HRA CFR (excluding settlement payment)";
 - 2.2 the amounts set out in column 3 of the table below for the amounts set out in the column headed "Total 2"; and
 - 2.3 the amounts set out in column 4 of the table below for the amounts set out in the column headed "Limit (rounded up to nearest thousand)"
