## TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 1. To identify the strategic challenges and opportunities associated with the caring role paying particular regard to:
  - Demographic changes
  - Developments in public policy
  - Changing relationships in families
  - Equality and diversity
  - Improvements in technology
- 2. To provide advice to Ministers and the Carers Strategy Cross-Government Board on:
  - Progress in delivering the strategic vision set out in the national Carers Strategy <u>Recognised, valued and supported:</u> <u>Next steps for the Carers Strategy</u>
  - How best to respond to the strategic challenges and opportunities associated with caring
  - Specific topics identified by Ministers.
- 3. In drawing up its advice, to act as an advocate for carers while paying due regard to existing and likely future fiscal and spending limits.
- 4. To provide advice at regular intervals so that it can be considered by Ministers and the Cross Government Board in a timely way.
- 5. To publish periodic reports setting out the evidence considered by the Commission and its advice to Ministers, key stakeholders and delivery partners responsible for delivering the Carers Strategy.
