Domain 2: Enhancing the quality of life for people with longterm conditions - baseline figures

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Domain 2 – baseline figures for indicators 2, 2.1, 2.4 publication of 2011/12 data

- 1.1. Baseline figures for the following domain 2 indicators are published here pending methodological work associated with their standardisation¹, at which point indicators will be included in the Health and Social Care Information Centre (HSCIC) Portal²:
 - 2, Health related quality of life for people with long-term conditions
 - 2.1, Proportion of people with long-term conditions feeling supported to manage their condition
 - 2.4, Health related quality of life for carers

Indicator 2 Health related quality of life for people with long-term conditions

- 1.2. Average health status score for individuals aged 18 and over reporting that they have a long-term condition, derived from responses to the EQ-5D survey instrument. The derived value takes a maximum score of 1 (full health).
- 1.3. For 2011/12 the estimated value is 0.73.

Indicator 2.1 The proportion of people feeling supported to manage their longterm condition

1.4. For 2011/12 the estimated value is 69.6%

Indicator 2.4, Health related quality of life for carers

- 1.5. Average health status score for individuals reporting that they are carers, derived from responses to the EQ-5D survey instrument. The derived value takes a maximum score 1 (full health).
- 1.6. For 2011/12 the estimated value is 0.81.

¹ These baseline figures are the first in these series. They have not been published on the HSCIC Indicator Portal as standardisation has been recommended by Methodology Review Group and is being currently investigated..
