

Secretary of State's determination of quarterly solar photovoltaic deployment

In accordance with Article 13A of The Feed-in Tariffs (Specified Maximum Capacity and Functions) Order 2010 (hereafter, "the Order"), the Secretary of State has determined that the deployment of solar photovoltaic (PV) installations for the period 01/08/2012 to 31/10/2012 was as follows:

Installations with declared net capacity of:	Aggregate capacity deployed in period (kW)
>0–10kW	61,048
>10–50kW	12,563
>50kW and stand-alone	24,657

For installations with a declared net capacity of 50kW or less, the data in the table above comprise the aggregate declared net capacity of relevant installations which, in the period above, were registered on the MCS database.

For installations with a declared net capacity greater than 50kW, the data in the table above comprise the aggregate total installed capacity of relevant installations which, in the period above, were determined by the Authority to be entitled to accreditation.

This determination is based on the 'MCS and ROOFiT Pipeline Statistics' table published by the Department on a monthly basis, and available at http://www.decc.gov.uk/en/content/cms/statistics/energy_stats/source/fits/fits.aspx.

This deployment data will be used by the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (Ofgem) under Article 13 of the Order to determine the FIT payment rates for solar PV installations with eligibility dates between 1 November 2012 and 31 January 2013, in accordance with Annex 3 to Schedule A to Standard Licence Condition 33.
