We've saved £10bn in 2012 / 2013, following a saving of £5.5bn last year and £3.75bn in 2010 / 2011.

Becoming a leaner, more innovative Civil Service

£3.4bn

eg by reducing the size of the Civil Service and reforming Civil Service pensions



Better management of big projects

£1.7bn

eg by reviewing and shaping large scale projects (including construction) and stripping out inefficiencies



Buying better as a single customer

£3.8bn

eg by linking together departments to buy goods and services and enforcing sensible controls on recruitment and use of consultants



Transforming how and where we work

£1.1bn

eg by improving online services, raising money through selling empty buildings and exiting expensive rentals in sought-after locations

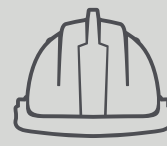
