Dear Tabitha

I understand that you have been copied into an email from a junior member of the UKCTCS which was circulated to the UKCTCS list encouraging sign up to the various websites supporting plain packs stating that *'You can only vote once on each petition, but I would seriously doubt that there will be cross checking between charity petitions so it may be worth signing all of them to get your money's worth!'*

I can confirm to you that we consider the email to have been inappropriate and ill-advised. We drew our concern to the attention of relevant individuals and a follow-up-mail was sent out to the same addressees clarifying that: *'Further to the previous email, it has come to our attention that organisations are collaborating to identify multiple responses, and multiple signing is not appropriate. Please do only choose one to sign.'*

The organisations party to the Plain Packs Protect campaign wish to make clear that multiple signing is completely unacceptable. Indeed all the organisations involved in the campaign have put considerable time and effort into taking appropriate steps in order to seek to prevent any multiple signing and in ensuring that all signatures are genuine. We will shortly be providing you with a copy of detailed protocols setting out the procedures that have put in place.
