Publication of Chronic Conditions guidelines for Line Managers and Employees

I am writing to you in my capacity as National Director for Health and Work to tell you about our recently completed Chronic Disease Guidelines for line managers and employees. These have been produced by the Health at Work Network, which is one of the five Networks within the Public Health Responsibility Deal** They result from our promise to provide organisations of all sizes with some practical guidance that will better inform and support employers and employees coping with a chronic health condition in the workplace.

Almost all employers will have employees who have or will develop a chronic condition, many of which fluctuate in their expression. Such conditions are a challenge to both employers and employees: often people wish to continue to work, but to do this need knowledge of their condition, good clinical care, and a positive understanding employer.

These Guidelines are now available. I hope that you will find them useful, and be willing to cascade them within your organisation, to raise awareness and put their principles into practice.
