

The most recent final figures for maintenance works for No.11, which includes the state rooms and offices and the No.10 flat, are:

- 2007-8 - £39,644
- 2008-9 - £37,022
- 2009-10 - £10,140
- 2010-11 - £32,651

This has covered the costs of essential maintenance work in the No.10 flat since May 2010 and has included:

- Electrical works and plumbing;
- Structural improvements;
- General maintenance and restoration; and
- Flooring.

No public money since May 2010 was spent on:

- Bathroom appliances, furniture, fixture or fittings;
- Wall furnishings; or
- Kitchen appliances, furniture, furnishings or accessories.
