



Republic of Guinea

COMMISSION REGULATION (EU) No 279/2010

This notification is issued in respect of the financial sanctions against the Republic of Guinea.

1. Her Majesty's Treasury issue this notification to advise that with the publication of Commission Regulation (EU) No 279/2010 of 31 March 2010 in the Official Journal of the European Union (O.J. L86. 1.4.2010, P.20) on 1 April 2010, the European Commission has removed four individuals from Annex II to Council Regulation (EU) No 1284/2009 with effect from 2 April 2010.
2. Annex II to Regulation 1284/2009 lists certain members of the National Council for Democracy and Development and individuals associated with them who are subject to prohibitions, principally the freezing of funds and economic resources belonging to such persons and a prohibition against making funds and economic resources available to such persons under Article 6 of Regulation 1284/2009.
3. The individuals who have been removed from Annex II are therefore no longer subject to the prohibitions imposed in Regulation 1284/2009.
4. Details of the individuals removed from Annex II to Regulation 1284/2009 as a result of Regulation 279/2010 are set out in the Annex to this notification.
