Notes on tables:

1. These numbers do not fall under National Statistics. They are based on Child Trust Fund (CTF) and Child Benefit (CB) administrative data. Account status information is taken from CTF endowment records as at 20 September 2012, CTF account information is taken from the annual provider returns as of 5 April 2012 and CB from the May 2012 data.
2. These tables cover accounts open for all children born between 1 September 2002 and 2 January 2011.
3. The data used here shows figures for the number of vouchers issued and the proportion of them that were used to open an account by parents or guardians. This is consistent with the methodology used for national account opening rates which are published on a quarterly basis. This is a different methodology from that used in the annual Detailed Distributional Analysis where only accounts for children born by 2 January 2011 that were opened by 5 April 2012 are included.
