The purpose of this Prior Information Notice (PIN) is to alert potential suppliers to an opportunity in relation to multiple potential requirements across the full range of consultancy and professional advice disciplines, including but not limited to business, management, financial and legal consultancy services. 2. The Delivering Differently: programme for local authorities is designed to support a small number of pioneering local authorities, either individually or in partnership, to select and implement new models of delivery for some of their services

for some of their services. 3. Drawing on a £1,000,000 fund, local authorities participating in the programme will have access to bespoke professional support to enable them to review which model is right for the service and decide how to implement it. This review will consider delivery by Voluntary Community or Social Enterprise (VCSE) groups or a public service mutual*, as well as joint ventures with other public and private sector providers.
