



Local alcohol action areas

The local alcohol action areas project has been set up to tackle the harmful effects of irresponsible drinking, particularly alcohol-related crime and disorder, and health harms.

Twenty areas across England and Wales have been established as local alcohol action areas. These are areas in which local agencies, including licensing authorities, health bodies and the police will come together with businesses and other organisations to address problems being caused by alcohol in their area.

Work in the local alcohol action areas will be focused on the key aims of reducing alcohol-related crime and disorder, and reducing the negative health impacts caused by alcohol. Underpinning both of these will be the goal of promoting diverse and vibrant night-time economies.

Each area has chosen to address one, two or all three of those aims, listed below.
