INTRODUCTION

1. This document contains historic versions of all tables previously published in Section 4 of the Armed Forces Compensation Scheme (AFCS) Official Statistic.
2. Please note that all historic versions of the Armed Forces Compensation Scheme (AFCS) Official Statistic have been removed from the DASA website, due to a processing error resulting in the incorrect allocation of claims to the in-Service and post-Service categories. This error did not affect Section 4 (Recipients of Guaranteed Income Payments). However, as all historic versions of the AFCS publication have been removed from the website, this separate document has been published with historic versions of tables from Section 4. These tables cover data up to the end of Q4-2009. The latest five quarters of data (Q1-2010 to Q1-2011) are provided in the latest version of the AFCS Official Statistic, also released on 9 June 2011.
3. Please note that there was a change in source data for this section and data from 1 January 2009 onwards has been supplied by SPVA. Data prior to this date was provided by Paymaster.
4. The figures in this section prior to 1 January 2009 do not include claims awarded on the SPVA interim system, which covered the period of 6 April 2005 to 31 October 2005. Data from 1 January 2009 onwards includes claims awarded on the interim system.
5. Please note that the tables are presented in the same format as originally published and therefore table numbers and formats may have changed over time.
