## Quarterly Manning Report :

### Defence Personnel by Location – 1 July 2011

This statistical release presents figures on the National and International locations of all UK Regular Armed Forces Personnel and MOD civilian personnel. It sources military data from the Ministry of Defence Joint Personnel Administration System (JPA) and civilian data from the Human Resource and Management System (HRMS). Due to ongoing validation of data from JPA, UK Regular Forces location data are currently provisional and subject to review.

The tables present information on the stationed location of all UK Regular service and civilian personnel by UK Unitary Authority and Local Authority Area, as well as all international global locations. Data is presented for each Service by Officer / Rank breakdown and non industrial / industrial breakdowns for civilian personnel (including Trading Funds and Locally Engaged Civilians).

### Key Points and Trends

- At 1 July 2011, 87% of UK Regular Armed Forces and 82% of MOD civilian personnel were stationed in the UK.
- The strength of UK Regular Forces stationed in the UK fell by 3,280 (2.0%) between 1 July 2010 and 1 July 2011 from 163,740 to 160,460. Over the same period, the number of UK civilian personnel decreased from 66,760 to 66,270.
- The strength of UK Regular Forces stationed Overseas decreased from 25,310 to 24,120 (4.7%) between 1 July 2010 and 1 July 2011. Over the same period, the number of Defence Civilian personnel based overseas decreased from 12,300 to 12,120, this smaller than expected reduction, reflects the additional requirements for the training and support of military exercises.
- The number of UK Regular Armed Forces personnel stationed in Germany continued to decrease from 23,280 to 22,040 (5.3%) between 1 July 2010 and 1 July 2011 in line with the announcement made during the Strategic Defence & Security Review (SDSR). Despite this decrease, Germany still has the second largest population of MOD personnel after the UK.

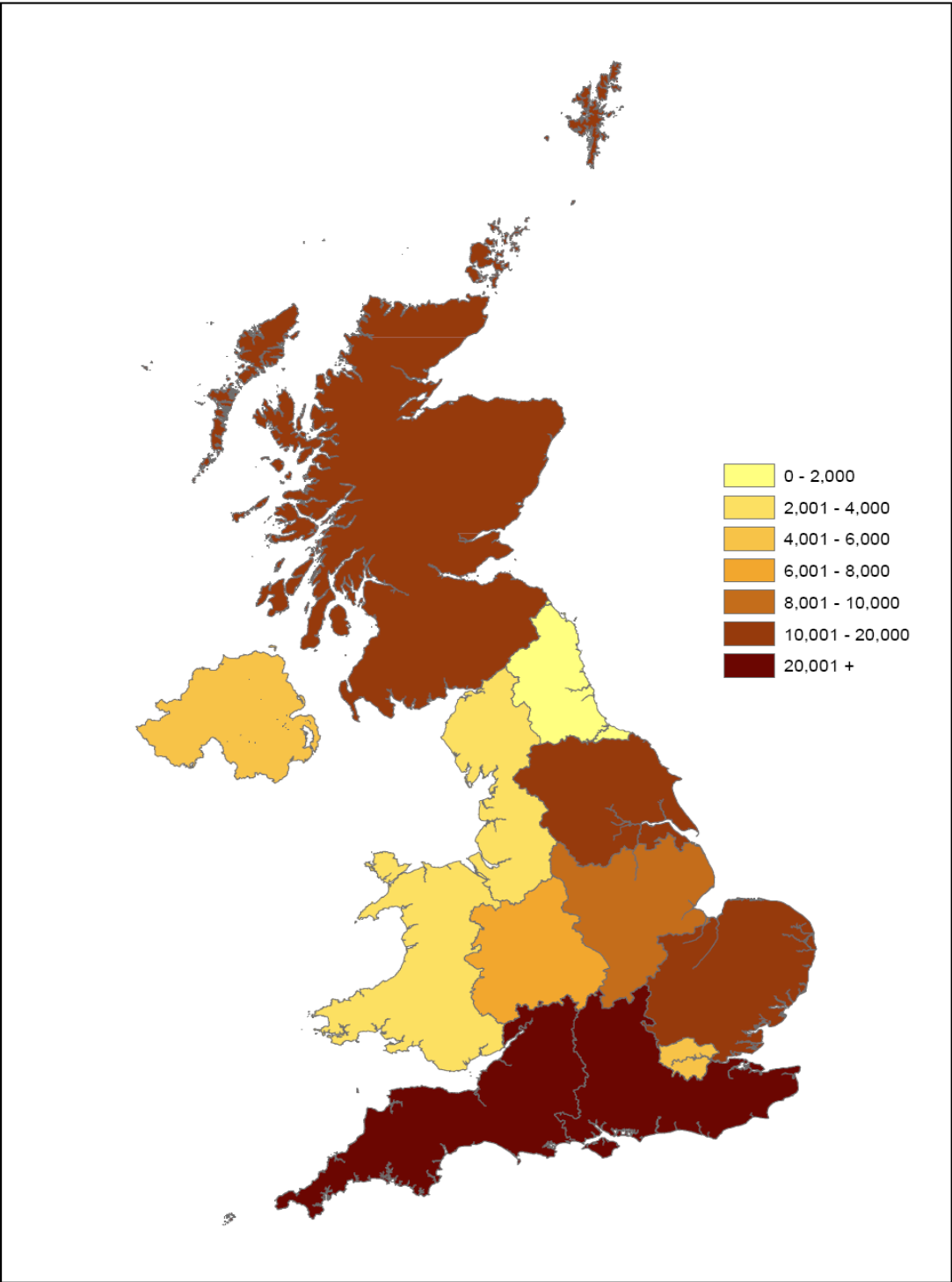

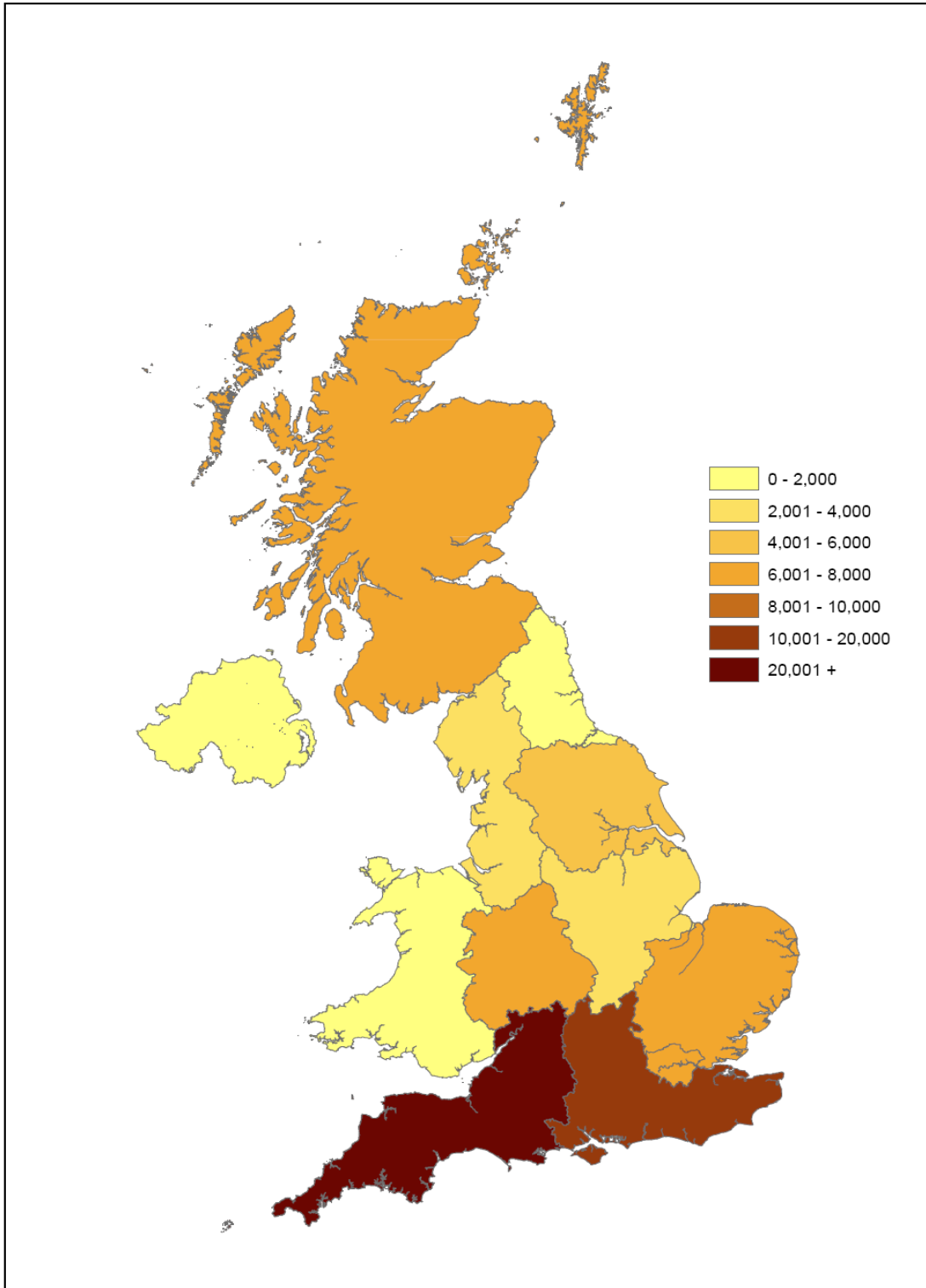

- <sup>1</sup> UK Regular Forces includes all trained and untrained personnel. Gurkhas, Full Time Reserve personnel, and mobilised reservists are excluded.
- <sup>2</sup> UK Regular Forces data are taken from the Joint Personnel Administration (JPA) system. Location data are based on the stationed location of the individual as recorded in the 'Assignment Location' field of the JPA system. The figures are based on Service personnel's stationed location and not their location of residence - where personnel work isn't necessarily where they live. Personnel deployed on operations to an area away from their stationed location are shown against their most recent stationed location.
- <sup>3</sup> UK stationed personnel with an unknown postcode, but for whom country data can be derived, are included in the total for that country. As a result, totals may not always equal the sum of the parts. Additionally, the grand total in section 1 includes centrally administered personnel and personnel with no known location.
- <sup>4</sup> Naval Service personnel on sea service are included against the local authority containing the home port of their ship.
- <sup>5</sup> Royal Air Force Other Ranks serving in the South Atlantic are shown against the location containing their home base.
