AIDU PROVISION OF TERMINAL CHARTS – CHANGE OF FOCUS

- 1. Following consultation with customers, No1 AIDU is continuing to change its focus from a paper-based environment to electronic provision of Air Data. The 24/7 availability of terminal charts via the MilFLIP website has reduced waste and enabled AIDU to operate a faster update and delivery of AI to a reduced budget. It has also allowed all endusers to operate a 'pull' distribution where, for example, they can instantly access US DoD information rather than pre-order 12 weeks ahead.
- 2. From 29 July 2010, the paper edition of the TCC (Terminal Charts Catalogue) will list only those charts that form the AIDU-produced core area, comprising: UK Military airfields, selected UK Civil airfields, selected European & OOA Ops airfields. Outside this core area, provision of TAPs will be electronic, through MilFLIP. All other routine requests are to be directed to Customer Services as above.
- 3. Customers currently holding route bags or other planning data are to be aware that wef 29 July 2010 EAG/ Navtech charts will no longer be supplied and users should download the required AI from Jeppesen using the JMCS link through MilFLIP. Those customers with a pre-arranged buy-in will continue to receive updates to their Navtech/EAG products until such time as they are able to download and print on site.
- 4. It is intended that the area of coverage remains comprehensive, and that customers are provided with the means to obtain the most current and accurate charts available. We welcome feedback.
