Subject: Farnborough International Air Show 2012 – Exhibition Clearances.

Introduction: The Farnborough Air Show takes place between the 9th–15th July 2012. The purpose of this Industry Security Notice (ISN) is to inform Industry of the target date by which they are to seek clearance for exhibition of defence related material in accordance with the guidance found on the Ministry of Defence (MOD) website at [\(link\)](#).

Issue: Requirement for Defence Contractors to obtain prior MOD exhibition clearance approval for exhibition of defence related material at the 2012 Farnborough Air Show.

Action by Industry: For material relating to MOD equipment programmes you are reminded to seek clearance from your contracting authority. For Private Venture (PV) goods/publicity material Industry should ensure that applications for approval to exhibit PV goods or publicity material for the Farnborough Air Show are received by MOD DefSy(S&T/Ind) by **1st June 2012**. Applications received after this date will be processed but no guarantees can be given that approvals could be provided in time for this exhibition. Please note this deadline is earlier than that previously published in the Farnborough International Air Show Exhibition Regulations

All applicants please note:

- We do not accept applications for exhibition/publicity material clearance by email as your application may contain information not releasable across the internet.
- We cannot provide clearance for technology funded and developed overseas as any technical security provisos and clearance is the responsibility of the government of the originating nation.
- We do not provide clearance for non-defence related material. e.g. office furniture, pens, pencils, caps, bags, novelty gifts, etc.
- Approval could take up to 4 weeks from receipt of the application.
