LIVE FIRING ARTILLERY-SAFETY CHECKS

Background

- 1. **What Happened**. A single 105 mm high explosive (HE) on a charge 4 round fired on 5 Mar 14 landed outside the Range Danger Area in a field close to the village of Patney, north of SPTA. HQ SPTA were informed on 7 Mar 14 and a SPTA safety check firing on artillery was imposed.
- 2. **Immediate Action to Permit Firing Whilst Investigation was Ongoing**. In order to allow firing to recommence there was a review of safe systems of training resulting in changes to written documentation and more significantly additional formal checks and over sight put in place. Firing recommenced on 14 Mar 14.

CONTROL MEASURES TO BE IMPLEMENTED.

- 3. With immediate effect all live firing artillery are to formally account for surplus charge increments, including double sign off before firing, to ensure the prepared charges cannot exceed the safe charge limit imposed by range control for the specific practice. Charges are to be broken down in a central area and are not to be broken down on the gun platform. RAUs are to ensure that Range Standing Orders (RSOs) are amended to reflect this with a mandated and accountable Proforma (example attached) which is to be kept for a minimum of 30 days. In addition RAU RSOs should be amended to reflect changes in practice that a SMIG will be mandated to be present in all gun areas during live firing.
- 4. The control measures mentioned in paragraph 3 will remain in place until such time as the investigation into this incident is concluded and final changes to prevent such a future occurrence have been developed and put in place. These measures will be implemented either through the issue of an additional RAN and/or amendment to JSP 403, Pamphlet 19¹ and the supporting RSOs.

EFFECTIVE DATE

5. The required action is to be taken immediately on receipt of this notice.
