I have reproduced the figures in this table whose source is annual returns from fire and rescue authorities to this Department. I have also included the latest available data which provides all firefighter fatalities in England from 1986/87 to 2012/13.

This shows that there were a total of 66 fatalities in this 27 year period since 1986/87.
