

Ministry of Defence (MOD) Contacts as listed in Open General Export Licences (OGELs)

This document summarises the contact details included in the terms and conditions of specific Open General Export Licences (OGELs) issued by the Export Control Organisation.

OGELs are export licences which are available in the public domain. They allow for the export of specified controlled items provided the shipment and destinations are eligible and an exporter can meet all the terms and conditions of the licence.

These conditions include, where specified, the requirement to obtain approval from the relevant team in the MOD.

If exporters can meet all the conditions (including notifying MOD), they need to register to use the licence on the SPIRE export licensing system – <https://www.spire.bis.gov.uk>

If the full licence terms and conditions cannot be met (for instance the destinations are not covered by the licence) and the goods are controlled, then an exporter will need to apply for a Standard Individual Export Licence (SIEL) via the ECO's SPIRE system.

“MOD F680” or “F1686” procedure is a means by which exporters can become informed of any objections or problems associated with a marketing or supply of particular military goods or technology, and can be advised of the protective security grading of the goods, and obtain clearance to sub contract or team on projects with overseas companies;

List X companies are obliged to follow the Cabinet Office Security Policy Framework which, in respect of this licence in the case of final exports to permitted export customers, requires them to obtain MOD Form 680 approval for goods protectively marked RESTRICTED or above.

9. OGEL (Export After Exhibition or Demonstration: Military Goods)

Under para 3(5) of this licence, exporters exporting goods or technology carrying a security grading of CONFIDENTIAL or above (or national equivalents) must ensure that the national requirements for transportation of protectively marked goods are covered and they are able to provide proof that transportation plans have been approved by the relevant authorities in the originating and receiving country.
