Introduction	Chair opened the meeting by passing on apologies from the Chairman and providing his focus for the coming year.
	Our first Annual Report (See Enclosures) had been issued and well received; the committee has done much to establish the role and presence of the VA&PC in Yorkshire and the Humber in its inaugural year. It is recognized amongst the top VA&PC's nationally. Moving forward our focus this year should be to robust evidence based action, providing influence within the region to better serve our veteran community. With regard to the Letter of Extension issued by the minister, the Chairman was confident that the VA&PCs would be endorsed further and carry on their
	important work.
Administration	The Secretary outlined the lack of centralized information from members. While the evidence of activity etc was within the members own domains the need to provide this for central storage in order to feed the annual report was stressed. The Secretary is to take a more pro-active role with members as necessary in this regard <b>[Action 5.1]</b> .

With regards to the SPVA '5 Bar Gate' reporting mechanism, the Secretary agreed to provide a simpler local model. He would then undertake to translate into the SPVA methods for upwards reporting.		
The Action Log from the previous meeting was reviewed. The establishment of 'Committee Standing Orders' for recurring activities was agreed.		
• <b>[Action 2.8]</b> Pending agreement nationally regarding biographies for the VA&PC website committee members are to provide biographies to the Secretary for our own use. The Secretary will liaise directly with those yet to provide.

The Chair provided copies of the DRAFT objectives developed for the PI and Health & Justice Sub Groups. The objectives for the LA and Welfare Groups are yet to be developed. <ul> <li>The Lead agreed to meet with the Selby LA in order to address its current RED status.</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Mrs Singleton provided input on Welfare vice the Sub Group Lead.</li> <li>The key challenge with providing centralized evidence was the subjective and confidential nature of the work; however, she agreed to liaise with the Lead and the Chairman to ascertain how this could be achieved. • The Welfare Service Report has not been received by the Secretary prior to the meeting. The Chairman is to liaise with the Welfare Sub Group Lead and SPVA in this regard, i.e. the timely provision of a meaningful central report in order to facilitate the VA&PC Monitoring function. [Action 5.4]

<ul> <li>The Health engagement is well established and David Jolliffe was able to provide a copy of the North Yorkshire Community Covenant. This is seen as a very useful document which could provide leverage with less enthusiastic NHS Trusts and LA's.</li> <li>The issue of Prosthetic Limbs was very much on the agenda of NHS</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>The issue of Prostrict Limbs was very much on the agenda of NHS Trusts and the Lead would continue to monitor progress in this regard.</li> <li>The Chair reported on progress in establishing a process for Veterans in Custody {NOTE – this is the period of time between arrest and disposal by the courts}. The Humber Probation Service are keen to establish a pilot scheme for seeking more appropriate methods of dealing with Veteran first time offenders where appropriate, including lining with the SPVA Focal Point.</li> </ul>		

	<ul> <li>Public Information</li> <li>The DRAFT PI Objectives for 2012 were circulated to the meeting. However, in the absence of objectives for LA and Welfare the meeting agreed to postpone discussion until the Secretary provided a full set for comment [Action 5.2]</li> </ul>

The LA and Welfare Leads are to ensure that welfare based provision is also signposted to the SPVA Focal Point by the Local Authority [Action 5.5].
