Local Service Support Grant (LSSG) 2014-15 Allocations

THE LOCAL SERVICES SUPPORT GRANT DETERMINATION (2014/15) [No. 31/2330]

The Minister of State for Local Government ("the Minister of State"), in exercise of the powers conferred by section 31 of the Local Government Act 2003, makes the following determination:

Citation

1) This determination may be cited as the Local Services Support Grant Determination (2014/15) [No. 31/2330]

Purpose of the grant

2) The purpose of the grant is to provide support to local authorities listed in the Annex to this determination towards expenditure lawfully incurred or to be incurred by them.

Determination

- 3) The Minister of State determines as the authorities to which grant is to be paid and the amount of grant to be paid, the authorities and the amounts set out in the Annex to this determination.
- 4) Payment of grant will be by 12 monthly instalments from April 2014 to March 2015.
