## Headteacher standards review - note from meeting 26 June 2014

## **Progress**

- 1. The third meeting of the headteacher standards review group took place on Thursday 26 June.
- 2. Two guest speakers discussed their views on headteacher standards:
  - a. Minister of State for Schools, Rt Hon David Laws
  - b. Director General for Education Standards Directorate, Shona Dunn
- 3. Some key points of interest from the day are:
  - a. The secretariat presented an update on the final report for the call for evidence. A full report on the response will be published in the autumn.
  - b. The group discussed the recommendations and additional observations they will want to make to Ministers when they submit the revised standards.
  - c. The group also discussed feedback received from meetings to test the draft standards.
  - d. The group had a drafting session to incorporate feedback from the call for evidence and testing.

## Next steps

- 4. The group will continue to test their draft standards with interested parties, including parents and headteachers.
- 5. The report to Ministers will be drafted ready for submission with the recommended new standards over the summer.
- 6. The next meeting will be held on Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July.
