

## Use of Green Cones in Traffic Management

### Work activity description:

Green cones are used for marking entrance points within traffic management.

### Investigation/findings:

The Department for Transport has requested the removal of our Toolkit Item 318A as they have questioned the legality of the use of the green cone. Discussions are going ahead to seek clarification with the Department and agree a revision to the toolkit item.



### Lessons learnt:

To date no negative or related road user incident from the use of coloured cones has been reported. The supply chain has reported significant benefit in using coloured cones to visually identify site hazards and influence operative's behaviours.

### Actions:

- Continue to use coloured cones until instructed not to.
- Ensure any coloured cones do not encroach on or form part of the Chapter 8 arrangements.
