

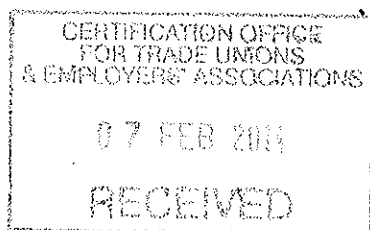
SCOPE OF THE AUDIT OF THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS
