AUDITOR'S REPORT (continued)

We have audited the financial statements of Workers of England Union for the year ended 31 December 2013, on pages 5 to 9, which comprise the Income & Expenditure Account and Balance Sheet and related notes. These Financial Statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and the accounting policies set out therein.

This report is made solely to the Union's members, as a body. Our audit work has been undertaken so that we might state to the members those matters we are required to state to them in an auditor's report and for no other purpose. To the fullest extent permitted by law, we do not accept or assume responsibility to anyone other than the Union and the Union's members as a body, for our audit work, for this report, or for the opinions we have formed.

As described in the Union's Rule Book and in the Statement of Officers' Responsibilities on page 3, the Union's Officers are responsible for the preparation of financial statements in accordance with applicable law and United Kingdom Accounting Standards.
