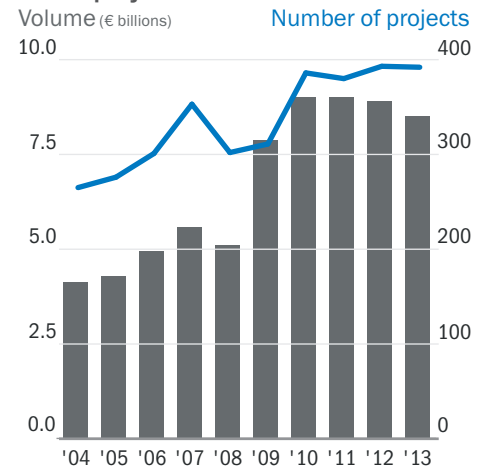

Overview

The EBRD provides project financing for banks, industries and businesses, both new ventures and investments in existing companies. They also work with publicly owned companies.

Each project is tailored to the needs of the client and to the specific situation of the country, region and sector. Direct investments generally range from €5 million to €230 million. They provide loan and equity finance, guarantees, leasing facilities and trade finance. (typically fund up to 35 per cent of the total project cost).

The Bank invests only in projects that could not otherwise attract financing on similar terms. For each project financed, they assign a dedicated team of specialists with specific sectoral, regional, legal and environmental skills.

Through donor funds the EBRD mobilise investment capital and expertise by giving local business access to consultant experts. Donor programmes are funded by governments and international institutions, and are managed by the EBRD.
