

## Local Government Expenditure over £500

Thank you for your email of 4 November 2010. Your email has been passed to the Directorate for Local Government and Economic Growth and I have been asked to respond. I apologise for the delay in replying.

From January 2011 local authorities will be required to publish details of all their expenditure over £500. We do not currently expect this requirement to extend to maintained schools. Local authorities' expenditure on goods/services which are used by schools should count as local authority expenditure for this requirement. This should include local authorities' spending of the proportion of the DSG that they retain centrally. Individual schools' delegated budgets are paid to them through their local authority, but this should not count as local authority expenditure even where schools use their local authorities' accounting system for their own accounts

Also of some concern here is whether the further instalment of related grants (revenue and/or capital) should not still be received by March 2011. You'll recall that authorities received such special capital grant amounts in or by March 2009 & March 2010; and revenue grants at same time and a further revenue amount (also toward recurring costs incl'g print etc costs) was to come to us by end of 2010/11.

The Coalition Govt, eg via DCLG, does appear to continue to recognise the burden(s) on local resources of new initiatives or requirements from the centre.

In November 2010, for example, we at Hyrxibum BC received a calculated share (some 79k) of an overall ? 3.43m toward Extra Admininistration Costs associated with supporting the NNDR one-year increase in small business rate relief (SBRR) — emanating from the Chancellor's June 2010 emergency budget announcements. However - and I realise that a different division within the DCLG may be dealing with this - the centre's urging for the **Online Monthly Publishing of Spending over 7500** has not, so far, included any promise of special grant to support the local resource implications taking place (significant staff time in developing, implementing initially & ongoing, running and reviewing / redacting before publishing, etc etc). AT HBC an assemblied group, convened by me, has produced an integrated draft for a recent month - and the live intro is currently mainly dependent on the latest view awaited from the \Leader of the Council led by 1, and possibly others, made an appropriate related comment / suggestion in October during that 1st-19th Oct 2010 consultation period; but no response appears to have been included in further documents from the centre on 7th December.



There has been a good deal of debate about the Government's transparency agenda in local government circles and, at Bracknell Forest, we are committed to publishing all the data we can to meet the targets we have been set. The guidance on spend data published by the LGA has been helpful and we expect to be fully compliant with this by January 2011.

What concerns me though is the target for tenders and contracts. This is a far taker order for most authorities than spend data, because, unlike spend, purchasing is rerely controlled centrally. In common with many of our peers, we operate a highly devolved model for Council procurement. Whereas our central professional team handles all the larger contracts, most of the routine low level purchasing is done by literally hundreds of operational staff within departments. Our central database only covers the larger, more formal contracts. Proposals to publish all tenders, requests for quotation, individual orders and contracts down to £500 therefore present a significant challenge. Yet despite these inherent organisational difficulties, we have as yet seen no guidance whatsoever, even in draft, on what precisely is expected. For comprehensive publication of contracts and tenders therefore, the January target is beginning to look highly optimistic. Even the Royal Borough of Windsor and Maidenhead have not thus far been able to publish this data.

My fear is that far from reducing bureaucracy in local government as we intend, we are in danger of creating a whole new swathe of administrative work for officers who we would rather see delivering front line services.



The YPLA are reviewing academies' financial reporting and monitoring arrangements, and their review is taking account of the wider transparency agenda.

If the rule was applied to the grand total of the journal (which is always very large) every finy amount would be reported which is undesirable. Therefore the rule is applied to each line of the GPC journal regardless of the grand total.

7 - The Open Government Licence (under which the data and information that appears on data gov.uk is licensed) states that: "The Controller invites public sector bodies owning their own copyright and database rights to permit the use of their Information under this licence." As such the license can freely be applied assuming that the few caveats are observed, as per. http://www.nationalarchives.gov.uk/doc/open-government-licence/. Ideally, data should be published to data gov.uk as well as appearing on your own website, as data gov.uk represents a central portal for public sector data that enables citizens to readily access data from a central hub.

At Buckinghamshire County Council, we have started to collect information about £500 payments in readiness for publication on our web-site. In the course of this work a number of questions have arisen. I would be grateful if you could provide me with a prompt response to the following:

- 1 Column 1 asks for a URL to identify the authority. How do we find our id for this?
- 2. Column 5 asks for Invoice Number. Is this the posting number held in our system for the invoice, or the supplier's own invoice number?
- 3. We have a mixture of schools where some have local bank accounts (LBA) and some do not. For LBA schools we do not hold details of supplier payments on our corporate system, so we would need to implement a process for these schools to provide the details from their SIMS system. Should we exclude schools from the data we publish?
- 4. We make payments to HMRC for tax deductions for sub-contractors as part of the construction tax deduction scheme. Should these be included in the data we publish?
- 5. As well as payments recorded against supplier accounts we also make payments from Imprest accounts. These are unlikely to exceed £500, but if they do should they be included?
- 6. If, as the guidelines indicate, we show payments and then break these down by individual invoices because they are coded to a range of services, and then break these down by line items because of multiple-coding, this will produce an enormous amount of data. Is this really required? Would it not make more sense to publish details of all invoices over £500 rather than payments? 7 How do we apply for a re-use licence?







I'm sending this email also to <u>transparency@local.gov.uk</u> because in the meantime I've re-looked at the Appendix A of the revamped/revised Guidance Doc of 7/12/2010 - copy of Appdx A attached - and a comparison of the 'Minimum' parts of that with **the Hyndburn BC proposed content** (as given in my 23/12 email) is as follows:

Name of body / organisation making the payment — we do not have a column for this in the HBC template as it should be obvious that the payments are all by Hyndburn BC, however a 'desirable' unique & nationally recognised identifying code could be used to allow for use in users' manipulation / downloading of the data.

Service Label ('Minimum unless organisational unit or Service Code is used') it's noted that the guidance now refers to CIPFA's very recently published 'SeRCOP' (Service Reporting Code of Practice for LAs 2011/12) which is replacing the Best Value Accounting COP. We will look at the SeRCOP (a hard copy is on order with CIPFA since before the Christmas & New Year local holiday); and our Service Cost Centre comes from cost centres in our accounting system and should suffice as used primarily for internal management reporting - eg "Parks & Open Spaces".

Service Code - at HBC we have deliberately avoided showing in our draft any codes etc superfluous to readability (le we have lifted automatically the *name* of the Service Cost Centre from the accounting system, without then also giving the cost centre *code* of 6 characters).

Organisational unit or department, responsible for spending the money ('Desirable when SeRCOP is used, otherwise mandatory') - not a separate column in HBC draft - please see comments above re Service Label and HBC Service Cost Centre name.

Expenditure Category eg travel costs. The Appdx A allows for 'Internally used expenditure type'. At HBC our **Account Detail** is a 'subjective' description of accounting code suffix, lifted from our system eg "Agency Staff". In effect, this may encompass the 'desirable' SeRCOP detailed expenditure type.

Expenditure Code ('The account code which represents the expenditure type') - at HBC we have deliberately excluded this detail account code of 4 characters, which relates to above-mentioned Account Detail name - for same reason as given above for excluding Service Code.

Narrative description for the details of the transaction - in Appxix A this is 'Desirable' rather than 'Minimum' - however, at HBC we have the equivalent **Description** column in our draft, giving a succinct description of spend from such existing data field in Accounts Payable system - eg "Seasonal Staff W/E 26/9/10". This complements (and will follow immediately after) our 'Service Cost Centre' and 'Account Detail' names for publishing.

Payment Date (dd/mm/yyyy) - we are already including **Payment date** as H8C payment transaction date. In our draft for October 2010 spend payments / credit notes, we had such dates as "05-Oct-10" etc. so we may need to change to "05/10/2010" etc.

Transaction number to act as a reference no, when dealing with enquries or FOI requests - at HBC we're currently intending that the **HBC ref no** comprises creditor/supplier number & invoice payment batch ref no.


