

## Horse medicines record - To be retained for at least 5yrs

- The Veterinary Medicines Regulations require the information in the table below to be recorded for **all food producing** animals; this includes any horse that has not been declared as “non-food producing” in their passport
- If a veterinary surgeon prescribes an “essential substance” this must also be recorded in the passport, except where the “non-food producing” declaration has been signed.
- For all horses, (both food and non-food producing) a record of **all vaccinations** must be kept in your horse’s passport.
