values also includes quasi- and non-court bodies whose decisions are recorded in the

same or similar manner as a court case outcome.

Comments This code structure is concerned with judicial structure; it does not refer to a physical

location such as a court building.

Examples of a National Court Code are:

1972 Norfolk Magistrates Court (refers to the Local Justice Area (LJA) of Norfolk. Magistrates from this bench may habitually sit in any one of a number of physical

court houses (e.g. Norwich, Kings Lynn, Great Yarmouth)).

9983 VOSA (refers to the Vehicle Operations Safety Agency in its capacity as a fixed

penalty issuer).
