Comments This standard is used in the exchange of criminal case data between the LAA (MAAT system) and HMCTS (Libra system). The message content is fixed for all scenarios that trigger and exchange messages.

On the receipt of an application for legal aid being received by the LAA, an initial enquiry message is sent to Libra. At this stage the status is that the application is pending a decision (status AP). The data item is required in a result message for all offences/applications before the court.

Civil and interlocutory applications also need to be reported to the LAA. However, such applications cannot attract legal aid and thus have no Legal Aid Status. This creates the need for a value of NA (Not Applicable) to enable those matters to be reported even though they cannot have a valid Legal Aid status.
