The Merchant Shipping (Boatmasters' Qualifications, Crew and Hours of Work) Regulations 2015 – Local Regulations

Notice to all operators and masters of all vessels on inland waterways and on limited coastal operations.

This notice should be read in conjunction with MSN 1853 and replaces MGN 334 (M) and its Amendment.

Summary

This notice gives information on port and navigation authorities' local navigational requirements and byelaws, and where to obtain further information on them.

1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Merchant Shipping (Boatmasters' Qualifications and Hours of Work) Regulations 2015 (The BML Regulations) came into force on XX XX 2015 and apply to masters of vessels operating on inland waterways and limited coastal areas¹.
- 1.2 Full information on the structure and requirements of the BML Regulations are contained in Merchant Shipping Notice (MSN) 1853.
- 1.3 To ensure the safe conduct of navigation a Boatmaster must be aware of local information for the area they are operating in and comply with any local knowledge requirements for that area.

2. Definitions

- 2.1 "Local Information" means an awareness of the local navigational rules that a harbour or navigation authority may have in place under its local byelaws or regulations.
- 2.2 "Local Knowledge" means knowledge of the features and characteristics within an area that present a hazard to safe navigation, and how to deal with them. It also means a more detailed knowledge of the local requirements referred to in 2.2 above. Local Knowledge Endorsements (LKE) are covered in MSN 1853.

- 2.3 “Inland Waterways” means all categorised waters as defined and listed in Merchant Shipping Notice 1837, as amended, and any other non-categorised inland waters.
- 2.4 “Limited coastal area” means an area of no more than 5 miles from land and no more than 15 miles from point of departure or arrival (excluding waters of category A, B, C or D).

3. Scope and application

- 3.1 As well as knowledge of the general “rules of the road” for navigation, a Boatmaster needs to be familiar with any local rules and regulations in force for the port or inland areas in which they operate. Therefore the Boatmaster must have an awareness of any navigational requirements, or restrictions, under a harbour or navigation authority’s local regulations or byelaws.
- 3.2 Candidates for the Tier 1 Boatmaster’s Licence will be tested on that awareness as a matter of course, as part of the on-board examination for their generic Licence. That testing will cover the local rules and byelaws for the area where they are being examined, and immediately adjacent waterways. If a Tier 1 Boatmasters’ Licence holder subsequently goes to different areas, they must develop the same awareness of the harbour/navigation authority’s local requirements for each area, as this is fundamental to safe navigation and good seamanship.
- 3.3 Candidates for the Tier 2 Licence will have to demonstrate similar awareness of local requirements for the area/s in which their on-board assessment takes place.

4. Local licences and Local Knowledge Endorsements

- 4.1 In areas where there is a local licence (eg a boatman’s licence), the holder of a relevant Boatmasters’ Licence (or certificate) will not be required to hold the local licence. (Pilotage requirements are not affected).
- 4.2 In areas where the Secretary of State had determined that an LKE is required the Boatmaster must hold the relevant LKE to operate in that area.

5. Local regulations notified to the MCA

- 5.1 Annex 1 below lists those authorities that have advised the MCA about their local regulations. It describes the area covered by the port/harbour authority (where that information has been provided), and provides contact details from where more information can be obtained.
- 5.2 The information in this notice is reviewed annually. Boatmasters should always contact the relevant port/harbour authority to confirm any updates to the information contained here

- 5.3 A port/harbour authority with an entry in this notice should contact the MCA to advise of any amendments. A port/harbour authority which would like their details included in this notice should contact the MCA.
