Subject: East Anglia ONE Offshore Wind Farm Order 2014
Proposed amendments to the Deemed Marine Licences

Further to the grant of the East Anglia ONE Offshore Wind Farm Order 2014 (the **Order**) by the Secretary of State on 17 June 2014, East Anglia ONE Limited (**EAOL**) has conducted a detailed review of the provisions of the Deemed Marine Licences (**DMLs**) contained within the Order.

Following from this review, which focused in particular on the practicalities relating to the required documentation as well as working up proposals for pre-construction surveys, construction monitoring and post-construction monitoring, EAOL has identified a number of areas in which it is felt the DMLs would benefit from amendment, these areas were then subsequently discuss at our last project meeting.

Therefore please find enclosed a table setting out EAOL's proposed amendments to the DMLs, along with reasoning for each change. We also enclose revised DMLs and a comparison showing the requested changes to the Order as granted.

We would be grateful for further discussion with the MMO relating to the acceptability of these changes and the mechanisms for issuing revised DMLs and will be in contact to arrange a meeting in due course; ultimately we would be grateful for confirmation that these amendments can be accommodated by 3rd October 2014.
