The results are available here but they have been summarized in such a way that they cannot be cross referenced.

For example it describes what proportion of respondents were male and what proportion are 55+ but I does not allow cross-referencing to determine what proportion were male and 55+.

I would like to request the original, line level, anonymous, data required to make this kind of analysis possible. preferably in a compressed .csv .txt or .xls readable format, by email or other digital sharing method.

I would also like to know the methodology behind the survey, the script, the contact method ect.
