Notification of Change: Update to 'Case Marker (Descriptive)' Standard

The entry in the tabe below replaces the 'Case Marker (Descriptive)' Element standard in version 5.0 the catalogue.

This new Version, version 2, of the standard is in effect from the Approval Date given in this document.

The next published version of the CJS Data Standards Catalogue will include the revised version of this standard.

The list below summarises the changes made from Version 1 to Version 2:

- Four new code values have been introduced to support the 'Code of Practice for Victims of Crime':
 - o KD Kidnap / false imprisonment
 - o PT Persistently Targeted victims
 - SX Sexual offence victim (other than Rape see RP)
 - o VI Vulnerable or Intimidated Victim
- The Description for the code 'HP' has been changed from 'Hate Crime Homphobic' to:
 - HP Hate Crime Sexual Orientation
- A new code to mark a case involving a Child Witness in support of th 'Protocol between the Association of Chief Police Officers, the Crown Prosecution Service and Her Majesty's Courts & Tribunals Service to expedite cases involving witnesses under 10 years'.
 - o CW Child Witness
