The site agent CCFE is decommissioning the existing PBX in 2015 and implementing a separate VOIP solution. CNC will adopt a separate VOIP service due to differing security constraints.

The CNC will be following the lead of our sponsoring government department DECC as they replace their telephony and will utilise their framework which a supplier is being appointed in Jan/Feb 2015. CNC has no details of the DECC shortlist.
