

Customer Assistance Points now open

The final new Customer Assistance Points (CAPs) have recently opened, offering personal support to Service personnel and their families living in Service Family Accommodation (SFA).

The new CAPs aim to provide SFA customers with the opportunity for face to face discussion about any issues with the services provided by DIO Operations Accommodation and its maintenance provider in England and Wales, MODern Housing Solutions (MHS). Each office has a co-ordinator who will investigate problems, and help ensure that relevant actions are taken to help resolve issues raised.

The location of CAPs was agreed with representatives from the User community, with sites chosen to reflect areas where there are large numbers of SFA. Barbecue safety

A barbecue can be a fun way to enjoy the summer outside with your family, when the British weather permits, but there are some straightforward things you can do to keep your family safe:

- Make sure your barbecue is in good working order.
- Place the barbecue on a flat non-flammable surface away from sheds, trees and shrubs.
- If you are using a starter fuel or fire lighters, follow the instructions and use the minimum required.
- Never leave the barbecue unattended.
- Keep children and pets away from cooking area.
- Allow ashes to cool before disposing of them. Do not empty hot ashes directly into the dustbin, or throw away a hot disposal barbecue otherwise you could set your bin on fire.
