





Cereals usage by Millers, Brewers, Distillers and Maltsters UK - May 2015

Key points

- Milling industry, starch and Bioethanol used 543 thousand tonnes of wheat in May 2015, up 7.7% on May 2014. Of this 460 thousand tonnes was home produced.
- Brewers, maltsters and distillers used 156 thousand tonnes of barley in May 2015, down 6.3% on May 2014.
- After two seasons of limited home grown milling wheat millers have switched back to home grown due to greater availability. See figure 1.

- Imported milling wheat was 8.0% lower than May 2014, but over the year to date total milled wheat was up 7.7%.
- Barley used for brewing, malting and distilling was down 6.3% against May 2014 but over the year to date was down -0.1%.
- Wheat used for brewing, malting and distilling was down -3.3% against May 2014 and over the year to date was down -6.0%.
- Oats usage was 10% lower in Jan Apr 2015 compared to the previous year and over the year to date was down 5.7%.

Usage of the Statistics

The UK government and the European Commission use these statistics to monitor and assess stocks of cereals as a key component of our food security. The estimates contribute to the UK cereal balance sheets published by the Agricultural and Horticultural Development Board AHDB. Grain processors and traders use the estimates to help assess market conditions.

There are no revisions to previous estimates.
