PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2015
FOOTPATH 13 WICKHAM BISHOPS IN THE DISTRICT OF MALDON

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is 3 August 2015.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The definitive line of Footpath 13 runs directly across the middle of the field and the proposal is to take it around the field edge. The property in question (Ballards) is up for sale.

SCHEDULE

[PART 1]

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

A length of Footpath 13 Wickham Bishops of undefined width and shown by a bold black continuous line on the Order map starting from point **A** on Grange Road at grid reference 8375, 1172 and running in a north westerly direction across the field for a distance of 213 metres to point **B** at grid reference 8360,1186 where it connects to the highway known as Wickham Hall Lane.

[PART 2]

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

A Footpath being 2 metres in width shown by a bold black broken line on the Order Map commencing at the aforementioned point **A** and running in a generally westerly direction along the field boundary for a distance of 185 metres to point **C** at grid reference 8358, 1172 and then in a northerly direction along the field boundary for a distance of 154 metres to the aforementioned point **B**.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 17 August 2015]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 28 September 2015]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 9 November 2015]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order(s) must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone must keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.
