RE: FREEDOM OF INFORMATION REQUEST

Thank you for your email of 21st July requesting information on government subsidies in the energy sector.

Specifically you asked for information regarding the most recent annual figures for:-

- Direct fossil fuel subsidies
- Indirect fossil fuel subsidies
- Direct renewable subsidies
- Indirect renewable subsidies

I note that your question asks for information relating to payments by the whole of Government. The Freedom of Information Act makes provision for disclosures of information held by public authorities and therefore, in relation to your request the Department of Energy & Climate Change (DECC) has only considered that information which it holds.

The UK defines fossil fuel subsidies as government action that lowers the pretax price to consumers to below international market levels. The UK has no fossil fuel subsidies.

In 2014-15 the amount paid to support renewable technologies is shown in the table following. It should be noted that the Renewable Heat Incentive (RHI) scheme and support for innovation are funded through general taxation whereas the Renewables Obligation (RO) and small-scale Feed-In Tariffs (FITs) schemes are funded through electricity bills.
