The official measure of relative deprivation for small areas

## The IMD ranks each small area in England

from:

most deprived area



32,844 small areas (called Lower-layer Super Output Areas) in England with an average of 1,500 residents each









comparing small areas across England



identifying the most deprived small areas



exploring the domains (or types) of deprivation



comparing larger areas e.g. local authorities



looking at changes in relative deprivation between versions (i.e. changes in ranks)



quantifying how deprived a small area is



identifying deprived people



saying how affluent a place is



comparing with small areas in other **UK** countries



measuring real change in deprivation over time
