# **NOTICE OF ORDER**

# WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53

Nottinghamshire County Council (South Leverton Footpath Nos. 27-32, Grove Footpath No. 15 and North Leverton with Habblesthorpe Footpath Nos. 22-24 and Restricted Byway No. 25) Modification Order 2009

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. Following an earlier exchange of written representations, the Inspector appointed to determine the Order issued a letter in which she proposed to make modifications to the Order as drafted. Following advertisement of those proposals objections/representations have been received.

The **start date** for the above Order is **1 October 2015**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case which contain evidence in respect of the Inspector's proposed modifications only.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications will be to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the above Area by adding the rights of way described in the Schedule below and as shown on the Order Map.

## South Leverton Footpath No. 27

Commencing from a point, SK 79137992, at the junction with South Leverton Footpath No. 5 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 401 metres in a generally south-south-easterly direction to a point, SK 79237959, at the junction with Outgang Lane.

## South Leverton Footpath No. 28

Commencing from a point, SK 79067957, at the junction with Outgang Lane and proceeding for a distance of approximately 308 metres in a north-north-easterly direction to a point, SK 79127986, at the junction with South Leverton Footpath No. 27.

## South Leverton Footpath No. 29

Commencing from a point, SK 79127986, at the junction with South Leverton Footpath No. 27 and proceeding for a distance of approximately

1,079 metres in a generally north-north-easterly direction to a point, SK 79508085, at the junction with South Leverton Byway No. 15.

#### South Leverton No. 30

Commencing from a point, SK 79508086, at the junction with South Leverton Byway No. 15 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 183 metres in a northerly direction to a point, SK 79498104, at the junction with Broad Lane.

## South Leverton No. 31

Commencing from a point, SK 79498105, at the junction with Broad Lane and proceeding for a distance of approximately 679 metres in a northerly direction to a point, SK 79488173, at the junction with North Leverton with Habblesthorpe Footpath No. 22.

## South Leverton Footpath No. 32

Commencing from a point, SK 75758090, at the junction with Grove Road and proceeding for a distance of approximately 580 metres in a generally west-north-westerly, north-westerly and finally south-south-westerly direction to a point, SK 75248112, at the junction with Grove Footpath No. 15.

## Grove Footpath No. 15

Commencing from a point, SK 75248112, at the junction with South Leverton Footpath No. 32 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 764 metres in a westerly then southerly direction to a point, SK 74608095, at the junction with Grove Bridleway No. 4.

#### North Leverton with Habblesthorpe Footpath No. 22

Commencing from a point, SK 79488173, at the junction with South Leverton Footpath No. 31 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 165 metres in a northerly direction to a point, SK 79458190, at the junction with North Leverton with Habblesthorpe Footpath No. 5.

## North Leverton with Habblesthorpe Footpath No. 23

Commencing from a point, SK 79468189, at the junction with North Leverton with Habblesthorpe Footpath No. 22 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 201 metres in an east-south-easterly direction to a point, SK 79658184, at the junction with North Leverton with Habblesthorpe Byway No. 11.

#### North Leverton with Habblesthorpe Footpath No. 24

Commencing from a point, SK 78358214, at the junction with Main Street and proceeding for a distance of approximately 1,250 metres in a north-

westerly, west-north-westerly, westerly and finally southerly direction to a point, SK 76498199, at the junction with Retford Gate.

# North Leverton with Habblesthorpe Restricted Byway No. 25

Commencing from a point, SK 80988115, at the junction with North Leverton with Habblesthorpe Byway No. 15 and proceeding for a distance of approximately 1,065 metres in a generally easterly direction to a point, SK 82038104, at the junction with Coates Road.

#### Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 26 November 2015]

As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications, the applicant and any other person who has previously written to us in respect of the Order.

Everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the above date the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications and any other person who has previously written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the above date the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents, although these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications and any other person who has previously written to us in respect of the Order.

# Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 7 January 2016]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the above date, the Secretary of State will send copies of the comments received to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties <u>everyone should keep to the timetable</u> to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time.
