Title: Insurance Fraud Taskforce - fourteenth meeting

1. Actions from previous meeting

- Agreement was reached on the minutes for the 15 September meeting.
- The Chair fed back to the Taskforce on a conference he attended in Barcelona and noted that the only country that has mandated membership of fraud databases is Estonia, and that there are stronger links between violent crime and insurance fraud on the continent.
- The Chair also commented that the increasing use of automated braking may lead to more low impact, and less high impact collisions.
