Thank you for your email of 9 July 2012.

Your third paragraph states "Finally, are there schedules showing historical and pending cases per DNO? I assume that there must be for pending. If so could I have a copy please? The variance between each of the DNO's unpublished policies in dealing with wayleave matters is clearly a factor in your case load and an indication as to the efficacy of each DNO's approach. I see this as being useful evidence at hearings".

This request for recorded information held by DECC is being handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

We do not keep a historical list of cases per Distribution Network Operator (DNO). However, we do have data showing the total number of wayleave applications received per DNO and I attach a list showing this data for the years 2010/11 and 2011/12. I also attach a list detailing the number of cases pending for pre-hearing and hearings per DNO as at 10 July.
