RE: Breakdown of FITs Installations by their Connection Standard

Thank you for your Freedom of Information request received on 12 June 2012 as set out below.

Your requests, received 12 June from

“I would like to access the following information under a Freedom of Information request.

Using the Central Feed-in Tariff Register I can see statistics on the number of installations that connect to the National Grid under the 'feed in tariff' scheme.

I would like to know the breakdown of these installations by their connection standard. Whether it be G83, G59 or other. Connection applications and approvals are made to, and by, the Distribution Network Operators (DNO's). This information must then be reported centrally to a government organisation. I would like this information reported with a monthly breakdown from January 2010 to the present.”

We have considered your request in accordance with the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIRs) as the information you sought disclosure of, does in our view, fall within the definition of 'environmental information' as stated in EIRs. We have now completed searching for the information you requested.

The information requested is not held by the Department. Information on Feed-in Tariffs (FITs) accredited installations are held within the Central FITs Register which is owned by Ofgem who administers the scheme.
