

We were asked:

- How much did your council/department/authority spend in total on IT technologies and services during the 2013/2014 fiscal year?
- Who were the top-25 (if applicable) IT product and services suppliers with whom the council spent the most money during 2013/2014 fiscal year?
- Of that spend (in 2013/2014) what was the breakdown in spend on a) IT products b) IT software c) IT services d) other IT (please specify)?

- For comparison, how much did your council/department/authority spend in total on IT technologies and services during the 2012/2013 fiscal year?
- And, who were the top-25 (if applicable) IT product and services suppliers with whom the council spent the most money during 2012/2013 fiscal year?
- Finally, of that spend (in 2012/2013) what was the breakdown in spend on a) IT products b) IT software c) IT services d) other IT (please specify)?

We replied:

- A1. The Wales Office spent £163,650 on IT services in 2013-14 and £209,538 in 2012-13.
- A2. The Wales Office uses IT services supplied under Ministry of Justice contracts, and we do not hold IT contracts in our own right. You may therefore wish to ask the Ministry of Justice about who were their top 25 IT product and service suppliers.
