

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY DEFINITIVE MAP ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 8(2) of Schedule 15 to the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the Derbyshire County Council (Bridleway and Footpath along the non-classified highway known as Brushfield Lane - Parishes of Brushfield and Little Longstone) Modification Order 2014 proposes to modify the Order by providing for the following modifications:

- Delete the words "and Footpath" in the Order title wherever they occur in the Order and Order plans and replace the word "Footpath" with the word "Bridleway" elsewhere in the Order
- Amend the notation on the Order plans to show the length C to D as a Bridleway

A copy of the Order as submitted and a copy of the Order showing the proposed modification together with the Inspector's Order decision dated 17 November 2015 have been deposited at Derbyshire County Council, County Hall, Matlock, Derbyshire DE4 3AG and may be inspected free of charge during normal working hours.
