

International Education Council – Terms of Reference

The International Education Council works to identify actions that will lead to a major increase in UK education exports.

Members of the International Education Council will actively support the sector in developing sector-led solutions by:

- Acting as a champion and advocate for UK International Education Strategy;
- Communicating with and engaging all parts of the sector, industry and Government;
- Acting as an advisor to Government on behalf of the whole sector.

The International Education Council will do this by:

- Identifying what is required for successful delivery of the UK's International Education Strategy, including the sectors' capabilities and actions to help realise the sector's growth potential;
- Building long term sector partnerships that can deliver action programmes
- Challenging government, industry and sector bodies to enhance their own co-ordination, strategic thinking and interactions with each other;
- Horizon scanning for opportunities as well as monitoring progress of the International Education Strategy as the market environment changes - including drawing on the evidence base, commissioning research and evaluation, and sharing best practice.
