

When conducting assessments/tests for the Driver and Vehicle Licensing Agency (DVLA) on persons who have a medical condition that may affect their ability to drive safely what, if any, funding does the DSA receive for each one?

You can find the amount we charge the DVLA for each assessment/test we conduct on their behalf for those people who have a medical condition in the table below.

Assessment/test	Amount charged to DVLA per assessment/test
Medical assessment	£62.00
Eyesight test	£9.00
